**General Meeting May, 12th, 2011**

Treasure Karen Knoshaug reported that the guilds 20% was \$891.08 and \$60100 came from posters. For a total of \$1492.58. The \$125.00 from Joan Grouts will go into the scholarship fund. We mad \$205 on the raffle. The Pickle Barn account was \$2391.87-thus we lost \$300.00. The gross was \$5843 and it was noted we did better the last year considering it was a shorter show.

Sherrie Shipley sold a piece on consignment and will give 20% plus sales tax to the guild.

Other discussions on the necessity of having a barn and how to raise money for the guild followed.

Daryl presented the information on having a Christmas show at the outlet. Tom Hill the outlets manager has expressed approval the space could be as much as 4000 sq. feet. The idea for a poster came up and members were encouraged to bring art to the June meeting and the members can vote much the same as we do for the artist of the month.

Other related things were advertising and length of the show. Daryl passed a sheet for members willing to participate and work on committees. Thirteen members signed up to meet as a committee. The meeting was set for Thursday May 19<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 and Daryl said "be there or be square"

Sharon set the time for the Bylaws committee to meet as Saturday May 21<sup>st</sup> at 9AM. Darlene, Sharon, Jo Mary and Shirley Fulfs will meet and others are encouraged to join them.

The necessity of and additional summer meeting was brought up.

The March minutes were approved with a motion by Janet Baxter and a second by Shirley Fulfs.

Darlene proceeded to the election of officers; and committer for the next year. Janet Baxter confirmed she will continue on the hospitality and Nancy Lemuire has volunteered to do the news letter. Karen Silvernail volunteered to take over membership. James Weaver had already agreed to become secretary.

The need for treasures position to be a 2 year position and mentor in a new one was also discussed and Karen Knoshaug stated she would stay on as treasure . Karen read the requirements for the position of president and vice president. Diane Stiles volunteered to take over and vice president After a lot of discussion Daryl Dietz agreed to become president and was greeted with much applause!
